

The process for becoming a Eucharistic Minister of Holy Communion to the Sick at Christiana Health Care System, please complete the steps outlined below.

- **Volunteer Application** – Complete the online [Adult Volunteer Application](#). Please select “Exceptional Experience Team” under assignment preference and indicate MOC in the “Getting to know you” section.
  
- **Required Volunteer Paperwork** – Please print, complete, ink sign, and return the [required paperwork](#) to Volunteer Services via [Email](#), or fax to 302-733-3417. *Please be sure to include your driver’s license and social security numbers on the paperwork where required. If you do not have one, please indicate NA in the appropriate place on the form.*  
*Note: Review the [Volunteer Training Manual](#) to complete Annual Volunteer Education located at the end of the paperwork.*
  
- **Criminal Background Check** – Please complete all the required fields in the [PreCheck Release Form](#) so we may complete your criminal background check.  
*Note: After you have filled in your personal information, you must complete the disclosure form at the end which requires you to sign with the mouse. Your form will not be submitted until this step is completed.*
  
- **New Volunteer Orientation** – All volunteer applicants are required to attend a New Volunteer Orientation prior to beginning their assignment. Please select one of these sessions below and let me know which one you can attend. Please arrive 15 mins prior to allow time for registration.

- **Tuberculin (TB) test** – If you have had a TB test within the last 6 months or have a history of positive skin test, please follow the instructions on the form. If you have not had a TB test within the last 6 months and prefer to have it done at Christiana Care, you may report to Employee Health between 9:00AM and 3:45PM to obtain one at no cost.  
**PLEASE NOTE:** *Tests must be read 48 –72 hours after PPD is administered, so please do not come in on a Thursday as Employee Health is not open on weekends.*
